To be eligible to receive the Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP) Grant, you are required to submit verification of Illinois residency. **Please submit this form with the proof of Illinois residency documentation.**

Proof of Illinois Residency

Dependent students: Documentation of your parent's/parents' Illinois residency must be provided.

Independent students: Documentation of your Illinois residency must be provided. As an independent student, the documentation must indicate that you have physically resided in Illinois for 12 continuous months immediately prior to August 31st, 2016, the beginning of the 2016-2017 academic year.

Data from one or more of the documents listed below may provide proof that an applicant (or parent) is an Illinois resident. In order to be acceptable, the documentation must be issued with the name of the individual whose residency is being verified. As a reminder, for independent students these documents must indicate that you physically resided in Illinois from August 31st, 2015 through August 30th, 2016.

- Illinois driver's license
- Illinois identification card issued by the Secretary of State
- Transcript from an Illinois high school or college
- Utility or rent bills
- Residential lease
- 2015 Illinois tax return (signed copy)
- Illinois motor vehicle registration card
- Illinois voter's registration card
- 2015 Property tax bill
- 2015 Wage and tax statements (IRS Form W-2)
- 2015 IRS Form 1099-Miscellaneous Income Statements
- Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services
- Statement of benefits from the Illinois Department of Employment Security
- Statement of benefits from the Social Security Administration

Additional residency documentation will be required for January 1, 2016 - August 30, 2016.
