Welcome to the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) Preparatory (Prep) Course-Waiver Portfolio instructional packet. This was designed for you, an active working professional with real-life experience and education that is applicable for meeting course outcomes and the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN) Master's Essentials. In this prep course waiver, by successfully completing each module, you have an opportunity to earn a course waiver for education and professional experiences you have already acquired to allow you to move seamlessly into the Chamberlain University College of Nursing DNP degree program.

A trained faculty evaluator will evaluate your completed portfolio. Within each portfolio you have the opportunity to demonstrate your proficiency of established competencies that align with the course-specific outcomes and the AACN Master's Essentials. Each competency must be fully met, through narrative explanation and sources of evidence, for each course outcome in order to receive a course waiver.

There are five DNP prep portfolios for which course waivers can be earned. If your prior education and experience does not fully meet the proficiency requirements, you will need to enroll in the five required DNP prep course(s) (MSN core courses) and earn the credit before admission into the DNP degree program. You may complete the DNP prep course requirements through any combination of transfer credit (maximum of six semester hours), course waivers via a Chamberlain portfolio or successful course completion at Chamberlain.

It is important that you take time to thoroughly read the following portfolio specific area. **You will have only one opportunity, per course, to complete the portfolio.**

In the DNP prep portfolio, you will be responsible for providing a general narrative that addresses selected questions/topics. Also in the portfolio, you will be required to provide sources of evidence\* to support proficiency in each identified competency and a brief statement on **how the source of evidence meets each required competency.**\*\* The course specific general narratives and competencies were developed to meet the course outcomes. Each course outcome is aligned with the AACN Master's Essential. By successfully completing all required activities for the portfolio, you will demonstrate a proficiency of the course outcomes and AACN Master's Essentials.

\* Sources of evidence include but are not limited to letters of endorsement, curriculum vitae or resume, continuing education credit, published manuscripts, podium and/or poster presentations, awards and formal recognition, professional organization membership and advisory board participation.

\*\* The same source of evidence may be relevant, as support of proficiency, for more than one competency.

## PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION PROCESS

If you are a **prospective** student interested in submitting a DNP prep course-waiver portfolio, contact an admissions advisor for next steps.

If you are a **current** student interested in submitting a DNP prep course-waiver portfolio, contact your student services advisor for next steps.

Once you have been approved for completing the portfolio, you may access the portfolio with a link from the registrar's office. Before you begin work on the portfolio, review the video located on the home page to support navigation and successful completion. When you have completed all of the competencies in the portfolio, you will see a congratulations page. We recommend that you review the submission to ensure all items are included. When you are satisfied, click the **Submit My Portfolio** link. This will generate an email to notify an evaluator that you have officially submitted your portfolio for evaluation. The evaluator will then review your portfolio. A representative will contact you to share the outcome.

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## COURSE WAIVER PORTFOLIO INSTRUCTIONS – NR-500: FOUNDATIONAL CONCEPTS & APPLICATIONS

**To earn a waiver for this course you will be responsible for providing a general narrative that addresses selected questions/topics. You will also be required to provide sources of evidence to support your proficiency in each competency with a brief statement on how the evidence meets each required competency.**

### STEP 1: REVIEW COURSE DESCRIPTION & OUTCOMES

#### NR-500: Foundational Concepts & Application

This nursing course introduces the graduate student to the conceptual foundations and skills essential for the master's-prepared nurse. A framework for professional nursing practice, the scholarly communication of ideas, the use of critical inquiry and information dissemination, and the professional development of the master's-prepared nurse will be explored.

#### Course Outcomes

1. Examine roles and competencies of master's-prepared nurses essential to performing as leaders and advocates of holistic, safe and quality care. (PO 1-5) (AACN II, VI, VII, IX)
2. Apply concepts of person-centered care to nursing practice situations. (PO 1, 2, 5) (AACN I, III)
3. Analyze essential skills needed to lead within the context of complex systems. (PO 3, 4) (AACN I, II, V)
4. Explore the process of scholarship engagement to improve health and healthcare outcomes in various settings. (PO 4, 5) (AACN I, III, IV, IX)

### STEP 2: COMPLETE THE GENERAL NARRATIVE

Review the general narrative section of these instructions. In a written format, address each element presented. Include professional examples that support your discussion and description of the elements presented. To successfully meet this requirement, your written work should be 400-500 words in length. You will also need to use scholarly sources\* to support information that you present.

#### General Narrative

Discuss personal and professional values that guide nursing practice and the importance of self-awareness and cultural humility. Describe personal attributes that contribute to a healthful work environment including strategies used to address incivility in the workplace or promote a culture of civility. (CO 1, 2, 3)

Develop your written response in a WORD document and save to a flash drive. When you have approved access to the portfolio, upload your written responses to the submission area. Instructions will be provided on how to upload your document.

\*Scholarly sources come from a professional, peer-reviewed publication (e.g., a journal or a government report such as from the FDA or CDC); contain references for sources cited so you can find the original source of information; are written by a professional or scholar in the field and indicates credentials of the author(s); and are no more than five years old, unless a seminal piece of work. Most nursing, medical, science and social science journals meet these criteria. If an article seems too simplistic or is a brief summary, look for other references. Newspaper articles and layperson literature (e.g., *Reader's Digest*, *Healthy Life Magazine*, *Food and Fitness*) and information from Wikipedia and most .com or .net sites are not considered scholarly.

### STEP 3: DEMONSTRATE COMPETENCY

Each course outcome will have one to three different competencies for which you will need to demonstrate proficiency. You will be required to provide sources of evidence to support the proficiency in each identified competency with a brief statement on **how the source of evidence meets each required competency. You will need to provide, at minimum, one source of evidence per each required competency.** You may find that one source of evidence does not fully support competency in the proficiency. In this case, you are encouraged to use multiple sources of evidence.

To prepare for the completion of the portfolio, carefully read each course outcome and required competency. Identify which sources of evidence you will use to support the proficiency. Gather your evidence and save to a flash drive (sources may be saved as a PDF or WORD document). Write a brief narrative (150-200 words) on **how each selected source of evidence meets the required competency.** When you have been approved for access to the portfolio, you will need to cut and paste your written response in to the text box provided for each competency. You will also upload your sources of evidence from your flash drive.

NOTE: The selected source(s) of evidence must be directly related to the competency and topic.

Include professional examples that support your discussion and description of the elements presented. To successfully meet this requirement, your written work should be 400-500 words in length. #### General Narrative

Discuss the different patterns of knowing and provide examples on how these are applied in your professional practice. Identify one nursing theory that guides your professional practice. Be sure to include key concepts of the theory and how it addresses the metaparadigm of nursing.

To earn a course waiver in this DNP prep portfolio, you will be responsible for providing a general narrative that addresses selected questions/topics. You will also provide sources of evidence to support proficiency in each identified competency and a brief statement on how the source of evidence meets each required competency.

### STEP 1: REVIEW COURSE DESCRIPTION & OUTCOMES

#### NR-505: Advanced Research Methods – Evidence-Based Practice

This course provides an integration of EBP with research in order to foster holistic, person-centered care in diverse healthcare settings. Content related to research methodologies, problem identification, critique of findings and literature, and application to evidence-based practice is presented. Students will be provided an opportunity to practice learned principles through the development of an evidence-based project that focuses on quality improvement or safety.

1. Integrate EBP and research to support advancement of holistic nursing care in diverse healthcare settings.
