



2018-2019 ILLINOIS RESIDENCY VERIFICATION

To be eligible to receive the Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP) Grant, you are required to submit verification of Illinois residency. **Please submit this form with the proof of Illinois residency documentation.**

Proof of Illinois Residency

Dependent students: Documentation of your parent's/parents' Illinois residency must be provided.

Independent students: Documentation of your Illinois residency must be provided. As an independent student, the documentation must indicate that you have physically resided in Illinois for 12 continuous months immediately prior to September 3rd, 2018, the beginning of the 2018-2019 academic year.

Data from one or more of the documents listed below may provide proof that an applicant (or parent) is an Illinois resident. In order to be acceptable, the documentation must be issued with the name of the individual whose residency is being verified. As a reminder, for independent students these documents must indicate that you physically resided in Illinois from September 2nd, 2017 through September 3rd, 2018.

- Illinois driver's license
- Illinois identification card issued by the Secretary of State
- Transcript from an Illinois high school or college
- Utility or rent bills
- Residential lease
- 2017 Illinois tax return (signed copy)
- Illinois motor vehicle registration card
- Illinois voter's registration card
- 2017 Property tax bill
- 2017 Wage and tax statements (IRS Form W-2)
- 2017 IRS Form 1099-Miscellaneous Income Statements
- Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services
- Statement of benefits from the Illinois Department of Employment Security
- Statement of benefits from the Social Security Administration

Additional residency documentation will be required for January 1, 2018 - August 30, 2019.
