



## MASSACHUSETTS BUYER'S RIGHTS ADDENDUM

**A copy of the Massachusetts Buyer's Rights Disclosure must be provided to prospective students who are Massachusetts residents, at least 72 hours prior to the student signing a Chamberlain enrollment agreement.**

### Program Cost – Effective Beginning May 2019

The following cost information is used to determine financial aid availability and may not represent actual out of pocket costs. For instance, the Estimated Housing Expense represents a federally required housing allowance used in determining financial aid eligibility. Online students often incur no additional housing costs with their enrollment.

### Graduation Rate and Median Completion Time

The following chart reflects the percentage of students who were Massachusetts residents and graduated from a Chamberlain degree program during 2013 and 2014. Graduation rates are impacted by the average length of time students are enrolled, transferred credit hours and enrollment intensity and, therefore, may not be suitable for comparing to other institutions. The rates listed below do not factor in whether the student has been enrolled long enough to complete the program.

### Loan Nonpayment Statistics

Massachusetts requires institutions to disclose a loan nonpayment percentage. The Massachusetts loan nonpayment percentage includes those students that were not required to make payments because they continued their studies, were active in the U.S. military, were physically disabled or qualified for deferral or forbearance or under other terms as established by the U.S. Department of Education. The Massachusetts nonpayment figure for Chamberlain University is 27.3%.

The official three-year federal cohort default rate for all institutions in 2014 was 3.4%. For Chamberlain University that rate was 2.3%.

### Placement Rates and Employment Statistics

Massachusetts law requires schools to disclose graduate placement rates and employment statistics. Chamberlain University gathers graduate employment information through a variety of means. Generally, the information is gathered from forms graduates complete and sign electronically. Chamberlain University also may collect data through in-person, telephone, or email interviews with graduates or from third-party sources. However, Chamberlain University neither verifies with employers nor guarantees the accuracy of information gathered. Because Chamberlain University does not verify employment data with employers and instead relies on the information gathered, for the purpose of this disclosure, Chamberlain University discloses a *graduate placement rate* and *total placement rate* of 0% for all programs.

Chamberlain University provides career and employment seeking advising and assistance. The use of the term "Placement" here does not imply that Chamberlain University places students with employers at the conclusion of their studies.
