### Proof of Illinois Residency

#### Dependent Students

For a dependent student to be considered an Illinois resident in order to receive a scholarship and/or grant:

- the parent who is required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) must physically reside in Illinois and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home at the time the initial FAFSA was completed and processed by the Central Processing System (CPS);
- or
- if Illinois becomes the parent's true, fixed, and permanent home after the initial FAFSA is filed, the student's and the parent's state of legal residence and permanent mailing address must be corrected to indicate Illinois on the Student Aid Report (SAR)/Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR). The corrections must be received by the Illinois Student Admission Commission (ISAC) while data is still accepted and processed for the applicable academic year.

#### Independent Students

For an independent student to be considered a resident of Illinois s/he must have physically resided in Illinois for 12 continuous full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year for which assistance is requested and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home.

### Acceptable Documentation

#### Instructions

#### Independent Students

Your document(s) must show proof of residency from August 31, 2019 to September 1, 2020. This may require multiple documents to be submitted to prove proof of residency across each month within the date range.

#### Parents of Dependent students

Parents of dependent students are only required to submit one document showing proof of residency between August 31, 2019 and September 1, 2020.

Statement of benefits from the Social Security Administration	Must turn in 12 statements showing residency for each month	Yes:
Utility or rent bills in the applicant's (or parent's) name	Must turn in 12 bills showing residency for each month and must list a "start" and "end" date for services	Yes:
IL high school or college transcript	Cannot accept Chamberlain University transcripts. Acceptable transcripts must show the campus attended for each session, including dates for each session and also include the student's name and address.	Yes:
Residential lease in the applicant's (or parent's) name	Must show honor date on or before August 31, 2019. If lease expires before September 1, 2020 must show additional proof for missing months.	Yes:
Wage and tax statements (IRS Form W-2)	Must submit statements for 2019 and 2020	Yes:
Statement of benefits history from the IL Department of Healthcare and Family Services	Must turn in 12 statements showing residency for each month	Yes:
